	Attend a Study Abroad 101 Information session (visit international.appstate.edu for dates)
	Meet with Academic Advisor to discuss course plan/courses to save for semester abroad
	Research program options – think about cost, location, academics, and lifestyle (studyabroad.appstate.edu)
	Follow us on social media @AppStateOIED
	Apply for (or renew) your passport, if applicable
	Meet with your Study Abroad Advisor (international.appstate.edu - Education Abroad Advising)
	Start your OIED application
	Research Scholarships! international.appstate.edu/scholarships and ncs.appstate.edu
	Meet with a Financial Aid Advisor if you receive grants or loans/Complete FAFSA
	Submit your OIED application
	Familiarize yourself with your program cost
	Check your email regularly for updates on your application
	Start researching your host country
√	POST-ACCEPTANCE
	Attend a Post Acceptance Meeting (dates/times found in your OIED application portal)
	Begin your 2nd step application - application to your host institution or affiliate program
	Complete your Course Approval Form
	Look into/start preparing for your Visa application - not sure if you need one? ASK!
	Apply for housing at your host institution (if applicable)
	Request a release from App State housing (if applicable) housing.appstate.edu
	Attend the Pre-Departure orientation sessions
	Make sure there are no holds on your student account/drop any courses for your semester abroad
	Familiarize yourself with who you'll pay: App State, or your affiliate/external program
√	BACK HOME
	Follow any necessary steps/complete any forms to have your transcript sent to OIED (affiliate programs)
	If new approvals are needed, contact appropriate department chairs for approvals
	Update your résumé and LinkedIn
	Participate in re-entry activities!
