CREDIT CONVERSION

A full time course load at Ara is 60 credits per semester (2-4 courses) and most courses are worth 15 or 30 credits each. The following credit conversion scale should be used.

15 Ara credits = 4 Appalachian credits

30 Ara credits = 8 Appalachian credits
