## **CREDIT CONVERSION**

A full time course load at Freiburg is 30 ECTS credits with a minimum load of 24 ECTS. ECTS credits are normally converted on a 2:1 ratio. Some standard conversions are listed below:

1 ECTS = .5 Appalachian credits 2 ECTS = 1 Appalachian credit 3 ECTS = 1.5 Appalachian credits 4 ECTS = 2 Appalachian credits 5 to 6 ECTS = 3 Appalachian credits 7 to 8 ECTS = 4 Appalachian credits 9 to 10 ECTS = 5 Appalachian credits 12 ECTS = 6 Appalachian credits 15 ECTS = 8 Appalachian credits 20 ECTS = 10 Appalachian credits 24 ECTS = 12 Appalachian credits 30 ECTS = 15 Appalachian credits
