## **CREDIT CONVERSION**

Masaryk uses the ECTS credit system. A full time course load at Masaryk is 30 ECTS credits with a minimum load of 20 ECTS. Appalachian students are required to take at least 24 ECTS credits per term. ECTS credits are normally converted on a 2:1 ratio. Some standard conversions are listed below:

1 ECTS =	.5 Appalachian credits
