CREDIT CONVERSION

NTU uses the CATS credit system. A full time course load is 60 CATS (30 ECTS) credits per semester. Most NTU courses are worth 20 CATS. The following credit conversion scale should be used.

10 CATS (5 ECTS) = 3 Appalachian credits

15 CATS (7.5 ECTS) = 4 Appalachian credits

20 CATS (10 ECTS) = 5 Appalachian credits

30 CATS (15 ECTS) = 8 Appalachian credits
