CREDIT CONVERSION

A full time course load at Kansai Gaidai is 14 credits with a maximum load of 20 credits (6 courses). All students must take the Japanese Language course.

Credits should transfer back on a 1:1 ratio. The mandatory Japanese language class is worth 5 credits and the Kanji/Reading courses and English taught courses are worth 3 credits each. To meet the full time load requirement students would take at least 4 classes (Mandatory language plus 3 elective courses).
