CREDIT CONVERSION

A full time course load at Okayama is 5 classes per week. All students must take a Japanese language course.

The Okayama semester is broken up into two 8 week quarters with most courses continuing for both quarters. Credits should be awarded on a 1:1 ratio.

Comprehensive Japanese (each level runs for 2 quarters) = 8 Appalachian credits

Reading and Writing (each level runs for 2 quarters) = 4 Appalachian credits

Elective courses (normally run for 1 quarter) = .5, 1, or 2 Appalachian credits per course

Independent Study (by arrangement) = by arrangement

Appalachian major/minor/general education credit will be awarded for all courses completed on this program with prior approval of the relevant department. This approval is obtained by completing the Course Approval Form with their academic advisor(s) and Department Chair, available from the student's online application. Students are urged to work closely with academic advisors and education abroad staff to plan a course of study allowing for progress toward their degree.
