CREDIT CONVERSION

Sunderland uses the CATS credit system. A full time course load at Sunderland is 60 CATS (30 ECTS) credits per semester (2-6 courses). The following credit conversion scale should be used.

10 CATS (5 ECTS) =	3 Appalachian credits
15 CATS (7.5 ECTS) =	4 Appalachian credits
20 CATS (10 ECTS) =	5 Appalachian credits
30 CATS (15 ECTS) =	8 Appalachian credits
40 CATS (20 ECTS) =	10 Appalachian credits
