POLICY ON INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL INSURANCE COVERAGE

1. All students (undergraduate, graduate, and professional) traveling abroad and receiving Appalachian State University academic credit OR traveling on Appalachian State University-related business (not for credit) are required to obtain international emergency travel insurance from the University's authorized vendor. Exceptions are given to students traveling abroad on [ISEP Programs](#) and through [Appalachian Affiliated Organizations](#) with formal signed Agreements. In these cases, students are required to purchase their insurance through those organizations.
2. All Appalachian employees traveling abroad on University business are required to be covered by the international insurance policy. Employees must complete the online International Business Travel Insurance Form in order to be enrolled the Office of International Education and Development in this insurance policy.
3. HTH Worldwide Insurance and DRUM provides benefits while traveling overseas for coverage of accident and illness medical expenses, emergency medical evacuation, security evacuation, and repatriation of mortal remains.
4. The University's authorized international emergency travel insurance must be obtained for/by students traveling internationally regardless of whether the student traveler has other related coverage. The insurance can be obtained from the Office of International Education and Development prior to travel.
